§ 71.01 REGULATION; EXCEPTION.

No motor vehicle having a gross weight exceeding six tons shall be used, driven or operated over or upon any street or alley maintained by and under the control of said borough, except for local delivery.

§ 71.99 PENALTY.

Any person or party, operating a motor vehicle or combination upon any street, highway, alley or bridge, in violation of the weight limitation set forth in § 71.01, guilty of a summary offense and will, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$150, plus an additional \$150 for each 500 pounds, or part thereof, in excess of the maximum allowable weight of six tons. Failure or default in the payment of any such fine subjects the offender to confinement for a period of up to 30 days, in a correctional facility, as provided by law.
